WeekDayName

The WeekDayName function returns the name of the Weekday for the specified day.

Syntax

```
WeekdayName(weekday[, abbreviate[, firstdayofweek]])
```

Parameter Description

- weekday, a Required Parameter. The number of the weekday.
- toabbreviate, an Optional Parameter. A Boolean value Boolean value that indicates if the month name is to be abbreviated. If left blank, the default value would be taken as False.
- firstdayofweek, an Optional Parameter. Specifies the first day of the week.
 - 0 = vbUseSystemDayOfWeek - Use National Language Support *NLS* API setting
 - 1 = vbSunday - Sunday
 - 2 = vbMonday - Monday
 - 3 = vbTuesday - Tuesday
 - 4 = vbWednesday - Wednesday
 - 5 = vbThursday - Thursday
 - 6 = vbFriday - Friday
 - 7 = vbSaturday - Saturday

Example

```
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html>
<body>
<script language="vbscript" type="text/vbscript">

document.write("Line 1 : " & WeekdayName(3) & "<br />")
document.write("Line 2 : " & WeekdayName(2,True)& "<br />")
document.write("Line 3 : " & WeekdayName(1,False)& "<br />")
document.write("Line 4 : " & WeekdayName(2,True,0)& "<br />")
document.write("Line 5 : " & WeekdayName(1,False,1)& "<br />")

</script>
</body>
</html>
```

When you save it as .html and execute it in Internet Explorer, then the above script will produce the following result:

```
Line 1 : Tuesday
Line 2 : Mon
Line 3 : Sunday
Line 4 : Tue
Line 5 : Sunday
```
