

VBSRIPT WHILE...WEND LOOP

In a **While..Wend** loop, if the condition is True, all statements are executed until **Wend** keyword is encountered.

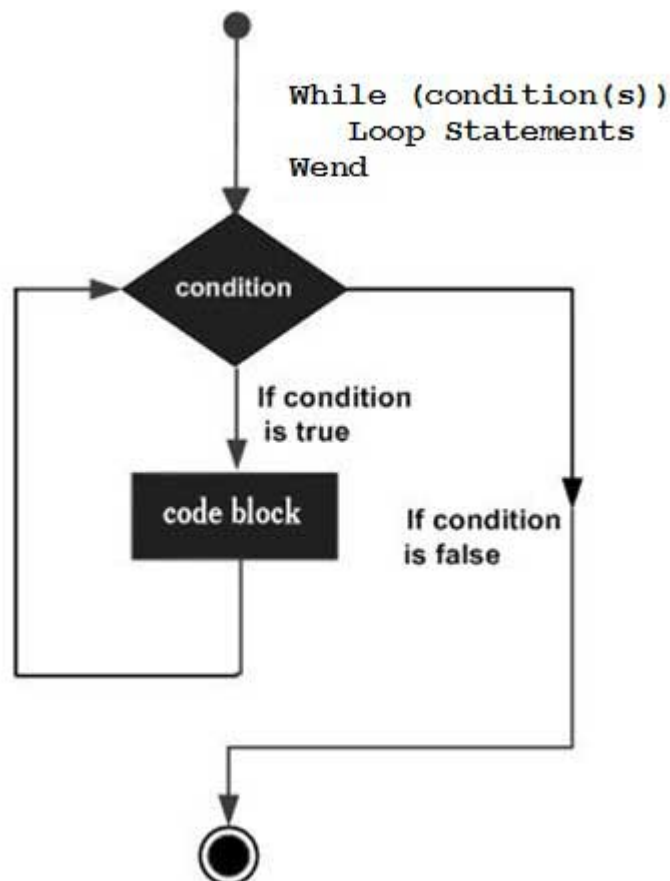
If the condition is false, the loop is exited and the control jumps to very next statement after **Wend** keyword.

Syntax

The syntax of a **While..Wend** loop in VBScript is:

```
While condition(s)
    [statements 1]
    [statements 2]
    ...
    [statements n]
Wend
```

Flow Diagram



Example

```
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html>
<body>
<script language="vbscript" type="text/vbscript">

    Dim Counter : Counter = 10
    While Counter < 15      ' Test value of Counter.
        Counter = Counter + 1  ' Increment Counter.
    Wend
```

```
        document.write("The Current Value of the Counter is : " & Counter)
document.write("<br></br>")
    Wend    ' While loop exits if Counter Value becomes 15.

</script>
</body>
</html>
```

When the above code is executed, it prints the following output in the console.

```
The Current Value of the Counter is : 11
The Current Value of the Counter is : 12
The Current Value of the Counter is : 13
The Current Value of the Counter is : 14
The Current Value of the Counter is : 15
```
