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The <p> element defines a paragraph of text and WAP browsers always render a paragraph in a new line.

A <p> element is required to define any text, image or a table in WML.

Attributes:

The <p> element supports the following attributes:

Attribute	Value	Description
align	- left - right - center	This is used to change the horizontal alignment of a paragraph.
mode	- wrap - nowrap	Sets whether a paragraph should wrap lines or not.
xml:lang	language_code	Sets the language used in the element
class	class data	Sets a class name for the element.
id	element ID	A unique ID for the element.
