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The <td> element encloses a single cell within a table.

It may appear only inside a <tr> element. It takes no attributes and may contain the following: flow text; images using the element; text style changes using the , , , <i>, <u>, <big>, and <small> elements; and anchored text using the <a> or <anchor> elements.

An empty <td> element, or one containing only whitespace, is legal and significant.

Attributes:

This element supports the following attributes:

Attribute	Value	Description
xml:lang	language_code	Sets the language used in the element
class	string	Sets a class name for the element.
id	element ID	A unique ID for the element.
